The NCFE Level 3 NVQ in Spectator Safety aims to provide a nationally recognised, competence based qualification appropriate to the work of stewards and marshals in spectator events, sports stadiums, sports competitions, music festivals and concerts, carnivals, fetes or anywhere where crowds of people are involved.

By gathering evidence at events, either paid or voluntary, anyone will be able to achieve this full level 3 award.

As part of the award you will attend two 1-day workshops developed to ensure you fully understand the role and responsibilities of an event steward and how to undertake the role safely.

On the workshops you will cover;

the role & responsibilities of stewards
emergency first aid
customer care
health and safety
equal opportunities
conflict management
crowd safety and control

Our trainers can provide specially tailored programmes to meet the needs of businesses and include sessions on front of stage work, radio and communication skills, incident reporting, conflict resolution, management, control & restraint, event traffic management, team working, introduction to care of VIPs, care for the elderly, child protection and those with special needs.

Assessment

Assessed portfolio, short end of course test on spectator safety and workplace observation.

If you have your own trainers, we can work with you to integrate and develop your in-house training into an NVQs in your workplace. We may also be able to secure funding on your behalf from Train 2 Gain to reduce the cost of the training to staff.

Are there any course requirements?

The minimum entry age is 16. You will need to secure paid/unpaid work as an event steward in order to complete this qualification. We will try to help secure work experience for any students who are interested in working in the industry.
