You will be expected to keep to normal working hours with your employer to earn your wages, and to also spend time at New College to gain key skills and to study for a business-related qualification. You need a lot of commitment to work all week and study on top of this. It can be hard, but it can be very rewarding.

What you will gain

By the end of your Apprenticeship, you will have been assessed in several ways by us and by your public services employer. You'll gain:

- Practical experience, skills and knowledge
- An NVQ at Level 2 for an Apprenticeship, or level 3 for an Advanced Apprenticeship
- Key Skills qualifications

The Apprenticeship may also lead to a permanent role with your employer. This is not guaranteed; however, you will certainly have the opportunity to apply for positions with them.
