CIEH Level 2 - Food Hygiene

Who is the course for?

Anyone working, or applying for work, in kitchens or undertaking front-line duties in preparing, processing or retailing food. It is recognised by Environmental Health Officers.

What is the course about?

The Food Safety (General Food Hygiene) Regulations, 1995 state that all food-handlers must be "supervised and instructed and/or receive training in food hygiene matters commensurate with their work activities". Even in the cleanest of workplaces poor practices in the handling and storage of food can lead to an outbreak of food poisoning.

In this course you will learn the basic principles of food hygiene; ensuring food is handled and stored correctly in order to prevent contamination.

Are there any course requirements?

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FOOD SAFETY IN CATERING

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION FOR EXAMINATION PURPOSES

Group A

- Signed valid passport (any nationality).
- Signed UK photo driving licence (both parts of the full or provisional licence are required).
- HM Forces ID card (UK.)
- Original UK Birth Certificate or certified copy (issued within 12 months of birth, but not a photocopy.)
- UK Adoption Certificate.
- Valid UK firearms licence with photograph.

Group B

- Certified copy of a UK birth certificate (issued more than 12 months of birth, but not a photocopy).
- Marriage Certificate (with translation if not in English) or Civil Partnership certificate.
- P45 statement of income for tax purposes on leaving a job (issued in last 12 months).
- Bank or Building Society statement issued to current address
- Pension, endowment or ISA statement. (issued in last 12 months).
- Gas/Electric/telephone/water/satellite/cable/mobilephonecontract/utility bill from current address (you can only use a maximum of one utility bill)
- Certificate of British Nationality.
- British work permit or Visa (issued in last 12 months)
- A payslip, with your address, and the employers name or logo (should be less than 3 months old)
- A credit card statement from current address.
- Child Benefit Book
- Letter from HM Revenue and Customs/DWP/Employment Service/local authority.
- TV licence in your current name and address (issued in last 12 months)
- Valid EU photo ID card.
- Signed UK paper driving licence
- Non UK Birth Certificate, with translation if not in English.

YOU MUST BRING 2 DOCUMENTS FROM GROUP A. AT LEAST ONE DOCUMENT MUST SHOW YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS AND AT LEAST ONE MUST SHOW YOUR DATE OF BIRTH

OR

ONE DOCUMENT FROM GROUP A AND 2 DOCUMENTS FROM GROUP B. ONE DOCUMENT MUST SHOW YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS AND AT LEAST ONE DOCUMENT MUST SHOW YOUR DATE OF BIRTH.

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
